

THIRD STREET PROMENADE EVENT RULES AND GUIDELINES

Third Street Promenade is a public right-of-way. The public must be able to access general Promenade space at all times. All events must be family-friendly, free, and open to the public. *Alcohol and controlled substances are not allowed on-site or as event sponsors.*

PERMITS

- <u>City of Santa Monica Community Event Permit</u>: Required if expecting 75+ attendees at any given time or including walls/structures over 8 feet tall
- LA County Health Permit: For food served onsite as required by LA County
- City of Santa Monica Building Permit: For walls and/or structures over 8 feet
- <u>City of Santa Monica Fire Department Special Event Permit</u>: Required if including 400+ square feet of tents/canopies and/or a generator over 6,500 watts

REQUIREMENTS

- COI: \$2 Million general liability, \$1 Million automobile liability, and worker's compensation
 consistent with the State of California requirements and list "Downtown Santa Monica, Inc."
 as additional insured
- Sitemap: Outlining event footprint and all items to be placed on the street and/or sidewalk
- Event Must be Attended at All Times: Event producer/brand ambassador and/or private security must always be on-site, including overnight hours
- Vehicles On-Site: Must have a driver nearby at all times. Overnight parking is not allowed.

FEES

- **DTSM. Inc.'s Administrative Fee:** DTSM, Inc.'s fees start at \$7,000 for up to three (3) days + \$1,300 for each additional day
- DTSM, Inc.'s Cleaning Fees: Billed only as needed
- City of Santa Monica Permit Fees: Issued by individual City departments on a case-by-case basis and must be paid in advance
- Attendance Fees: You cannot charge for the event or limit attendance to defined groups

LOGISTICS

- Vehicle Load-In/Strike: Before 8 am or after 10 pm only
- **Fire Access:** All tents, tables, etc., must be in the east traffic lane, sidewalk, or center-court spaces and cannot block fire hydrants or fire spouts on buildings
- On-site Power Access: Up to 15 amps available from each street light pole
- Recycling/Trash Disposal: DTSM, Inc. can provide access to alley bin rooms
- OffsiteTruck Parking: Open air lot at Fifth Street and Arizona Avenue
